## **Food song titles**

- Almost all classic ragtime was instrumental music
- The song titles run the gamut of place names, flowers and animals
- Publishers usually titled the songs and looked after the artwork
- Most titles are light-hearted and are meant to the give the impression that ragtime is "fun music"
- A lot of the song titles are associated with food:
  - The Wishbone
  - Sweetmeats
  - o Frog Legs
  - Crab Apples
  - o The Peach
  - Ham Bones
  - And this one: Pickles and Peppers



## Adaline Shepherd (1883-1950)

- born in Iowa, and moved to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, as a young adult
- worked as a milliner, and played piano by ear
- In 1906 (age 23), a local music publisher had her first rag notated by an arranger
- Sheet music sales of "Pickles and Peppers" would surpass two million copies
- four years later (age 27), she gave up her music career to raise a family
